We will continue to be independent learners; taking turns, being kind to one another and following our school rules.

Literacy

We will use the story of The Room on the Broom to help us to learn about rhyming words.

We will continue to have Read Write Inc lessons everyday as we develop our early reading and writing skills.

We will have lots of opportunities to practice our writing using pencils, chalk, paint and even shaving foam.

Mathematics

We will continue to learn about numbers to 10, focusing on matching quantities to the corresponding number. We will learn about one more and one less than a number.

We will create patterns and arrangements using 2D shapes. We will begin to use language related to time, for example yesterday, today, tomorrow, now, next and later.

Understanding the World

We will talk about special times and celebrations, including Bonfire Night, Diwali and Christmas. We will continue to observe seasonal changes and look for signs of autumn and winter. We will find out about animals that live in our local area, for example hedgehogs, squirrels and birds.

We will make poppies as we learn about Remembrance.

We will have a theatre trip to enjoy the Christmas Pantomime.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore different musical instruments and experiment with the sounds that they make. We will move in time to different instruments in our PE lessons. We will experiment with different techniques to create firework and Christmas artwork. In the construction area, we will design and create our own models of buildings in our local area. We will use clay to experiment with different techniques including rolling and kneading.
