Mathematics



Draw a butterfly outline. Fold it in half. Draw or stick things on to make a simple pattern. Look at the pattern and match the other side to make it symmetrical. Talk about what that means with your grown up.



Communication and Language



Have a go at writing your first **and** last names independently. Use the Look, cover, write check method to help you.



Literacy



Book talk. Choose one of your favourite picture books at home. Talk about the story with your grown up. Look for the author, the illustrator and the blurb. Can you remember what these are? Is your book a storybook or an information book? How do you know? Repeat with other books when you have a story at home.

Understanding the world

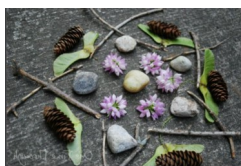
