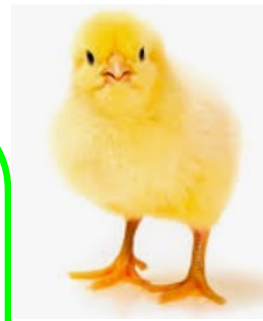
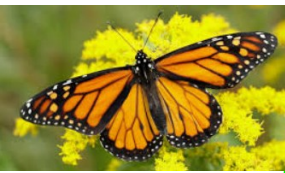


EYFS Summer 2021

Communication and Language

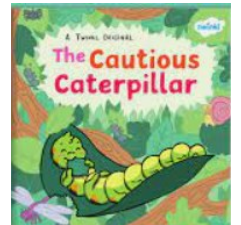
We will join in with rhyming and alliteration activities. We will use descriptive language to retell stories, events and to describe characters in books. We will build up our vocabulary and learn new words that are linked to our topic. We will use talk to communicate our ideas in the different areas of learning, both indoors and outdoors.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills using tools and equipment including scissors and pencils. We will practice different ways of moving including balancing, moving over, under and round Obstacles and negotiating spaces. We will practice throwing and catching and joining in with games. We will learn about how we keep ourselves healthy.

Literacy

We will practise phonics everyday in our Read, Write Inc lessons. We will write in simple sentences. We will share stories and non-fiction books that will help us to learn about life cycles, including The Cautious Caterpillar and The Hungry Caterpillar. We will retell the story of Hansel and Gretel as a link to when we learn about maps and our local area.

Maths

We will continue to read and order numbers and match numbers to the correct amount of objects. We will investigate simple addition and take away. We will halve and share different amounts of objects. We will compare and measure the length and size of different objects. We will investigate 2D shapes in our environment and start to learn about symmetry when we look at about butterflies.

Understanding the World

We will observe the changes that we see as spring changes to summer. We will learn first hand about the life cycles of butterflies, chicks and also the frogs down at our school pond. We will go for a walk in our local area and we will use a map to help us find out about local landmarks and historic buildings, including St Peter's church.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will create observational drawings and paintings of chicks and butterflies. We will create a press print of a butterfly. We will continue to explore instruments and music and create our own simple compositions. We will have opportunities to be creative independently both indoors and outdoors using music, role play and construction.
